Background to Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD)

The SIMD provides an analysis of deprivation across Scotland based on 6,976 datazone areas across Scotland. The SIMD identifies small area concentrations of multiple deprivation across all of Scotland in a consistent way. This is achieved by dividing Scotland into datazones with roughly the same population size and characteristics. The average number of people living in each datazone is around 700. The SIMD shows where Scotland's most deprived areas are, so organisations know where their work can have the biggest impact. The index ranks the data zones from most to least deprived based on seven aspects of deprivation – Income, Employment, Health, Education, Access to services, Crime and Housing – as well as giving an overall picture for the area.

For the purposes of SIMD 2016, West Dunbartonshire consists of 121 datazones. The datazone which is the most deprived in West Dunbartonshire is in the immediate geography of South Drumry; within the Your Community (YC) area of Linnvale and Drumry. The datazone which is the least deprived is in the immediate geography of Dumbarton East; within the YC area of Dumbarton East and Central West Dunbartonshire data zones - which equates to 40% of all data zones in our area - are within the 20% most deprived. West Dunbartonshire's national share is 3.4% of all data zones in Scotland.

The following YC area evidence sheets are grouped by the agreed Community Planning Partnership themes which are:

- Nurtured
- Safer
- Thriving
- Empowered
- Independent

Data available at YC geographies are used and focus on the comparison between these areas and West Dunbartonshire averages. They are ranked as such in terms of their performance against the WD average. They also include the individual SIMD domains and illustrate those within the top 10% most deprived and how often each YC area features overall and by domain. They show the average score for each domain and the range of scores as this highlights the discrepancies within localities.


