 Subject: RRTP Contribution Statements

Background

During the stakeholder workshops held whilst developing our Rapid Rehousing Transition Plan (RRTP), there was broad agreement with the idea that all partners should provide a RRTP Contribution Statement outlining how they could contribute to delivering the outcomes outlined in our RRTP. This was followed up at subsequent meetings of the Housing Solutions Partnership and partner agencies have been submitting their statements from May 2019.

All statements have now been approved by partner organisations and the Council. Overall they outline a range of ways that different organisations will contribute to delivering the outcomes of our RRTP. Good examples include RSL partners signing up to delivering the lettings targets for homeless households that are determined by our RRTP, the resourcing of tenancy sustainment officers and partners promoting the RRTP to other organisations. There is a strong commitment across the board to contribute to homeless prevention strategies and awareness of research on the relationship between health and homelessness.

What Next

The Scottish Government's response to the second iteration of our RRTP was keen to see stronger partnership working. As part of the wider annual review of our RRTP, we will review and update the action plan for years 2 to 5 and ensure that this is informed

by the information within the Contribution Statements received and also ensure that current actions inform the future review and update of all contribution statements.
