Dear Parent/Carer

We recognise the unprecedented challenge Covid-19 (coronavirus) is presenting to our communities and in light of this will be continuing to offer support to families from our hubs over the planned Easter holidays, Friday, April 3 to Friday, April 17, inclusive.

During this time we will continue to provide emergency childcare for the children of key workers who have no other alternative at our 14 dedicated community hubs. In line with guidance which has closed schools as a public health measure, provision is limited to children whose parents or principal carers work in sectors which are critical to the Covid-19 response, and who cannot be safely cared for at home.

Key workers should liaise directly with the Headteacher at the Hub they are using to confirm the access required.

In addition, families entitle to free school meals can continue to access provision during the Easter break. Packed lunches will be supplied by one of our partner organisations as part of our SHINE holiday hunger provision and can be collected as normal from Hubs between noon and 2pm.
