## Declaration of Results

This report is the Declaration of Results script for Returning Officer.

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 2 - Leven. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 13,820 and the number of ballot papers received was 5,951 giving a percentage turnout of $43.1 \%$. There were 129 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,165 .
